

Role of the “Toolbox”

- Support implementation of the Adaptation Strategies and Actions collaboratively identified by the Central Valley Landscape Conservation Project
- Support a coordinated landscape-scale conservation effort in the Central Valley.

Toolbox Steps

1. (Spring/Summer 2016):
 - Plan toolbox elements based on real uses of the Central Valley Partnership
2. (Fall/Winter 2016): Develop
3. (2017): Teach and support
4. (ongoing): Maintain and extend

Step 1: What's Coming Up

- May-July, with the **Project Development Team**:
 - Per-use-case brainstorming sessions about needed data, analysis, and tools.
 - Prioritize these.
- Summer, with the **Data Management Team**:
 - Create plan to accomplish priorities
 - Outline work for future phases
- Late summer, **Leadership Team**:
 - Approval of Toolbox Plan


Project Teams' Roles in Developing the Toolbox

- Project Development Team
 - Represent Partners' uses and needs, and contact for ongoing outreach
- Data Management Team
 - Help us identify methods and prioritize
- Project Leadership Team
 - Approve our plan

Per-Use Brainstorming Session


Specific Use
